

THE MAIN THOUGHT

Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds. (Hebrews 1:2, KJV)

UNIFYING PRINCIPLE

Where we come from often speaks volumes about what we are like. How are people rooted in what has come before? Hebrews affirms the ultimate origins of Jesus in the very life of God, and Matthew explains how He was the product of His long biblical heritage.

LESSON AIM

To take pride in the family roots of the faith and see one's calling.



UNIFYING TOPIC

Called Before Birth

LESSON TEXT

THE MAIN THOUGHT

But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. (Matthew 1:20-21, KJV)

UNIFYING PRINCIPLE

A newborn baby inspires us to wonder about the potential of every human life. How do we understand the designs of our lives? Joseph's call to form a family with Mary suggests God calls us to give hope to the world through our families.

LESSON AIM

To learn that God makes the impossible possible, asking us in the process to do the improbable.

To trust the voice of God through uncertainty and even with difficult tasks.



A Regal Response to Holy Light
